COVID Restrictions

- Bundaberg Golf Club conducts competitions using COVID-19 Safe Plans
- All businesses in the Hospitality Industry in Queensland must comply with the new electronic contact information requirements. These may include QR Codes, Online fillable forms, Online booking systems and digital spreadsheets. The club uses the QR Codes system. The Covid Safe Plans do not allow individual players an option.
- Players to score his/her own scorecard. Only one signature required. Verbally verify your score with fellow player prior to signing
- Bunker rakes have been removed
- Do not handle the flagsticks
- Social distancing signs will be displayed
- Hand sanitizer stations are available
- No hand shaking
- A box for completed morning cards will be available upstairs in the clubhouse. Entry of cards into the system will be done by Match Committee/volunteers. Afternoon cards must be handed to a member of the Veterans Match Committee, upstairs in the clubhouse.

Let's hope that sooner rather than later we will all be allowed to go back to playing golf under our 'normal' rules.
